The MAREA project, funded by the European Union under Erasmus+, aims to promote sustainable agriculture in both rural and urban areas. The project is a cooperation between Belgium, Germany, Italy, Norway and Croatia. MAREA focuses on four topics: socio-ecological agriculture, ecotourism, the preservation and dissemination of traditional knowledge and the relationship between cities and agriculture. MAREA stands for "Multifunctional Agriculture: Rural Education for Action". The name reflects the objectives of the project: a transition towards a sustainable lifestyle through the sharing of knowledge from rural regions.
